I. Subject Matter of the Agreement

1. The subject matter of the Agreement is cooperation in the form of co-organization on the international non-competitive show **The Artist's Book Triennial Martin 2021**, where the Main Organizer is the Turiec Gallery in Martin founded by the Žilina Self-Governing Region. According to its schedule, the exhibition part of the project will take place in the premises of the Turiec Gallery from October 2021 to February 2022 .

2. The subject of co-operation is the assistance of the Co-organizer in the preparatory phase of the project, i.e. in the collection and storage of art objects registered for the exhibition, ensuring their protection until the date of their transfer, handover, and subsequent takeover of the items after the project ends.

II. Rights and Obligations of the Parties to the Agreement

1. With regard to the organization of the international non-competitive exhibition The Artist's Book Triennial Martin 2021, the Co-organizer undertakes to ensure:

- promotion and distribution of artist applications within their own institutions;
- availability of premises for temporary storage of art objects from the registered artists from **April to June 2021**;
- average protection of artistic objects until they are taken over by the Main Organizer, to June 30, 2021 at the latest;
- handover of artistic objects to the Main Organizer on the date of transport;
- takeover of artistic objects after the end of the project on **May 2022**;
- temporary storage and protection of artistic objects in its own premises until they are taken over by respective artists;
- availability of a **contact person**—employee of the organization, who can carry out the obligations of the Co-organizer and ensure communication with the Project's Main Organizer;
- that requested records - **copies of documents** shall be provided to the Main Organizer of the Project, which will be used for the purpose of a grant program of the **International Visegrad Fund (IVF)**;
- provision of the manual's logo, of the **logo of the organization**, which will be used in the promotional and print materials of the project.

2. In connection with the organization of the international non-competitive exhibition Artist's Book Triennial 2021, the Main Organizer undertakes to:

- use the Co-organizer's logo and name on promotional materials and printed materials, at the exhibition premises, on the Main Organizer's website, on posters, invitations, and in the exhibition catalogue;
- provide the Co-organizer with the print materials related to the project organization: application forms, posters;
- hand over a share of printed outputs of the project (at least 5 catalogues) to the Co-organizer;
- to provide the Co-Organizer with 30 free tickets to the Artist's Book Triennial exhibition in Martin;
- provide the Co-Organizer with photo documentation from the event after the project is ended.

III. Final Provisions

1. This contract is concluded for a definite period of time: it begins on the date of entry into force of the contract and ends on **2022-June-1**.
2. The contract can be terminated:
 - a. by a written agreement of the Parties to the Agreement;
 - b. by withdrawal in the event of a breach of the obligations of either Party to the Agreement, if the breaching Party fails to fulfill its obligations despite a written notice. The withdrawal is effective from the moment of its delivery to the other Party.
3. Termination of this Agreement shall not relieve the Parties of the obligation to properly settle all the obligations under this Agreement.
4. The relevant provisions of the Commercial Code shall be used to regulate relations not expressly provided for in this Agreement.
5. This Agreement is written in two counterparts, of which one counterpart shall be received by the Co-organizer and the other by the Main Organizer.
6. The Cooperation Agreement shall be governed and interpreted in accordance with the legal regulations of the Slovak Republic. Any disputes or disagreements arising out of the Agreement or in connection with the Agreement, or its breach, termination or invalidity shall be settled by the Parties in good faith by agreement.
7. This Agreement may be amended or supplemented after mutual agreement by both Parties, all the changes shall be made in the form of written amendments and signed by the authorized representatives of both Parties.
8. The Parties to the Agreement declare that they have duly read the Cooperation Agreement before signing it, have signed it voluntarily, according to their true and free will, not in distress, or under significantly disadvantageous conditions. In order to prove their agreement, the authorized representatives of both Parties shall attach their handwritten signatures.
9. The Cooperation Agreement shall enter into force on the date of its signature by the Parties and shall become effective on the day following the date of its publication on the website of the Turiec Gallery.
